Watershed activities through check dam in nearby stream has ensured water availabilities around their farm. In comparison with other crops He is earning Rs.200-300 per day through floriculture. This has change their life because prior to that he was doing only traditional farming with limited income. Today he owns house, two wheeler, and their children are getting good education.
2	<u>Parvatiben</u> (Chilakota)	Parvatiben having five acres of land at Chilakota village, she has been associated with Sadguru foundation since last five years and involved in multiple activities as resource person in her village. She is the president of SHG federation as well as Drinking water scheme. Drinking water scheme sponsored by NARDES-GNFC is running smoothly since last three years and group is having corpus of Rs. 25000/- for repair and maintenance of drinking water scheme. About 25 household getting tap water at their door step on daily basis through this scheme. She has borrowed a loan of Rs.1.00 Lakh for decoration service business and she has partially repaid the loan.
3	<u>Revtiben</u> (Chilakota)	Revtiben is housewife and involve in agriculture activities. She is having land about 2 acres. She got training from sadguru foundation for Agriculture Diversification. She has started vegetable cultivation with tank based MIS system. Today she owns borewell with electric connection and growing vegetables as well as flowers on regular basis. She is earning Rs.4000-5000 monthly from vegetable cultivation and floriculture.
