Outcomes of Visit at Akshar Centre for Hearing Impaired Children, Vadodara on 29th September, 2016

About Akshar Trust:

- 1) The trust has been working as a charitable trust for hearing impaired children for **28 years**.
- 2) The District Administration has given Akshar Trust a 10,000 sq mt plot at Sherkhi village. The trust has later on set building as per their requirement.
- 3) Akshar Centre is the only school for the hearing impaired in Gujarat which is **Adapting Textbooks.** Akshar Trust is running school for Deaf children at free of cost.
- 4) There is no other school for the hearing impaired in **Gujarat which offers Hindi**.
- 5) The students can get admission though out the year and no age limit is set up for admission. Children with problems additional to deafness are also admitted.
- 6) The transportation facilities also offered by centre.
- 7) Akshar is the only 1 of 2 Centers, for the deaf in Gujarat, which is preparing students for Std. 12 Gujarat State board exams.
- 8) Akshar Trust is also associated in Teacher Training Programme D.Ed.SE (HI) and Teacher Training B.Ed. (SEDE).
- 9) Along with education, the centre provides facilities like Special Training in Art and Karate, Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychological tests etc.
- 10)Centre is equipped with Library, Science Lab and the Computer Lab within the campus.
- 11)The experts from outside is regularly invited by Trust to guide and innovative idea generation for students and teachers.
- 12)Workshop and awareness generations programs are routine part of activities of Akshar Trust.
- 13)The centre has received 3 school buses though donation for transportation of students.
- 14)Followings are the list of Awards received by Akshar Trust:
 - Akshar Trust was given Accredited Status by the Rehabilitation Council for 'Very Good Performance' in 2009.
 - Akshar Trust has received an 'Award for Excellence 2011 for Social Welfare by Individual, NGO or Institution' from the Federation of Gujarat Industries on September 10, 2012.

- Akshar Trust has also been provisionally empanelled with the National CSR Hub of the Tata Institute of Social Sciences.
- Akshar Trust has just been given the True Impact Awards of Jury Recognition, 2016 in the NGO Category by the District CSR Cell of Vadodara under the Chairperson of Mrs. Avantika Singh, IAS, District Collector, Vadodara.

About Beneficiaries:

- 1) The Trust is running their academic schedule at Sherkhi Village. At present there are total 132 **students** are there.
- 2) The beneficiaries are generally hearing impaired children. The students cannot hear and speak.
- 3) Students at centre are come from all socio-economic backgrounds.
- 4) The centre offers free hearing aids and ancillaries for underprivileged students.
